# The Work of Operation Guyana

## **Medical**

Since we started this work in 1992, we have hosted 156 Medical Mission teams, and have treated over 250,000 people in our clinics! All of these people have had an opportunity to hear the Gospel, and almost 7,000 have been baptized.

We have also hosted Medical Training, Surgical Teams and Medical Support at the Georgetown Public Hospital, and several other Medical Support Projects!

## **Church Support**

Operation Guyana has built five church buildings in Guyana, conducted well over 100 Vacation Bible Schools, taught over a hundred Advanced Bible Classes, hosted Workshops and Lectureships, and so much more.

We have started the Operation Guyana Bible Institute, and have conducted 16 Bible classes in 2010 alone. We have also helped teach in the local Preacher training School.

We have hosted benevolent projects, have dispensed thousands of Bibles, tracts, and Song Books, passed out Sunday School and Teacher supplies, and much more.
